	Archery GB Metrics I to V in all Archery GB categories. Single rounds may be shot on either day
Event format	Rounds will be shot in a single detail of up to three archers. Straw bosses on H frame stands will be used.
	Six arrows per end will be shot throughout the day. At the two shortest distances recurve and compound
	archers will shoot all their arrows on an individual 80cm 6 ring face. Longbow and barebow archers will
	be on dedicated targets and all archers on each boss will share a single, full size 80cm face. WA timing
	and shooting rules will apply and the rounds will be shot from the longest distance to the shortest
