- Venue:** Stratton Upper School Sports Field, Eagle Farm Road, Biggleswade, Bedfordshire SG18 8JB
- Rounds:** New National, Long National, National. (*Short National, Junior National, and Short Junior National according to age of juniors.*)
- Judges:** Brian Dunlop, Katy Lipscomb, and Pat Kerrigan **Lady Paramount:** Maggy Halliday
- Assembly:** Morning session 9.30 a.m., afternoon session 1.30 p.m. **Sighters:** 15 minutes after assembly.
- Awards:** Trophies for double rounds, medals will depend upon number of entries. **Richard Steele Memorial Shield** for highest scoring longbow archer in any round.
Mixed Team Challenge – 4 archers from same club, must include: 1 adult, 1 junior, 1 male, 1 female, 1 compound, 1 recurve, 1 longbow (or barebow) scoring any single round. **Laburnam Trophy** for barebow team - 3 archers from same club scoring any single round.
- Entry Fee:** £8 (single round), £14 (double round) per archer, **same as last year!** Please make cheques payable to “**Kestrels Archery Club**”.
